Objective: To offer a clean, safe, adult-supervised welcoming faith-filled environment during the 9:30 Mass on Sunday mornings for children ages one year and up to two years eleven months by Dec. 2nd.

Participants: St. James families; parents assume responsibility for certain Sundays each month -- 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. (approximate)

Parent requirements: The Sacramento Diocese requires adult volunteers who have contact with children to complete the Shield the Vulnerable training program once every three years. It can be done on line at www.shieldthevulnerable.org. Also, adult volunteers are to be fingerprinted. Forms are in the Faith Formation office.

Calendar: Follows the Faith Formation calendar for Sunday classes. Co-op begins Sunday, October 3, 2010.

Cost: \$15 per child

Location: St. Clare Room – Parish Memorial Center

Responsibilities: Greet families and assure sign-ins. Families are to label clothing and any items brought in for the day. These will be listed on the sign-in sheet.

Simple snacks provided by the Faith Formation Office. **Food allergies. Alert others to any child's allergies.

Report any needed supplies and /or repairs to the staff of the Faith Formation Office.

Pick up environment and restore toys to cupboards in hallway at the end of the morning.
