Safety of our children – to and from class – **Monday/Sunday**  
this side / reverse side

**Monday** Faith Formation classes 4-5 pm and 7-8 pm

The “B” Street parking lot will be used by our Faith Formation families for student drop-off. Parents who remain in their cars and go through the traffic drop-off curve should pull up as far as they can so that traffic moves smoothly through the circle. Students are to be dropped off so they exit on the sidewalk side of the car. The students will pass through the black fence to get to class. **We need parent volunteers to help us monitor this safe route—car to class.**

The “B” Street parking lot has **one cross walk located in the middle of the Parish Center which must be used** by anyone parking in this lot. Do not leave your car and cross to the Center or School anywhere but this cross walk. This is mandated policy by the Sacramento Diocesan Safety Committee after a visit to our grounds.

The 14<sup>th</sup> Street parking lot is the first choice for anyone walking their child(ren) to class. Please arrive early so you may park your car and use the pathways connecting the 14<sup>th</sup> Street parking lot to the Parish Center. Walk past the Parish Center to the black fence and pass through to take your child(ren) to class.

For student pick up, the traffic curve will again be used. The children will be walked by their teacher through the black fence to the sidewalk side of the car to get in. For those who park in the 14<sup>th</sup> Street parking lot, you will meet your child in this same pick-up area. (You may meet your child at the classroom as long as the teacher has been told you will do so.) **We need parent volunteers to help us monitor this safe route – class to car.**

**FOR THE SAFETY OF THE CHILDREN, DO NOT DROP CHILDREN OFF IN FRONT OF THE SCHOOL ON B STREET.**

**Sunday** Faith Formation classes 9:15, 9:30 and 10:30 am

All children in the **Preschool classes and Grades 1 and 2** on Sunday morning must be walked to the classrooms by their families before the start of mass. Our teachers try to be in class 15 minutes before the class time so you will be able to find a seat in church.

***Special Request:*** With the need for back-to-back classroom use each Sunday comes the plea for a quiet and quick pick up of the younger children. Come to the classrooms as soon as you leave church at the end of mass. (No need to leave mass early. Teachers stay with the children until each one is picked up.)

***Reminder:*** Please wait outside your child's classroom when picking them up after mass. It is very congested inside the kindergarten room where we sing; and it is necessary to have an accurate "headcount" for a safe return of all to their rooms. All children must be picked up from their classroom.

All children in **Grades 3 through 8** must be safe and protected when they come to class at 10:30. The Diocesan Safety Committee recommends that they, too, be walked to and from class. Most of the children will exit mass and walk over to the school on the covered sidewalk. Please be very careful and watchful if you must drop your child(ren) off and/or pick up in front of the school.

***AND*** – **Please be on time for pick up!** It is not a safe thing to let a child wait for you, at any time. **We need parent volunteers to help us monitor times on Sunday mornings: 10:15 to 10:45 and 11:30 to 11:45.**
